Our congregation, which has long served as a center of Jewish faith, learning and spirituality in Northern Westchester, offers the use of its facilities for funerals to past and present members of the congregation as well as those who are unaffiliated with the synagogue that wish to provide their loved ones with a service in a religious setting.

The Temple has extensive facilities in an attractive and secluded setting which provides privacy for mourning, remembrance and reflection. Featuring a large, well equipped Sanctuary with an organ, piano and sound system providing superior acoustics, the Temple provides a comfortable venue for family and friends to bid farewell in a House of Worship during the solemn occasion. In addition, the facility offers a separate space for use as a receiving room for family members and ample on-site parking as well as handicap access. The congregation possesses several Torahs in the ark located in the Sanctuary, including a rare scroll salvaged from a Czechoslovakian congregation which was obliterated during the Holocaust. It is this connection with the history of Judaism which makes Temple Israel a strong and vibrant Jewish community, a warm and inviting environment well suited for this difficult time when mourners gather to commemorate and celebrate the life of the departed.

In addition to providing a venue for a religious funeral, Temple Israel also has available cemetery plots at King David Memorial Park which is nestled in the gently rolling hills of scenic Putnam County, New York. Located in a rural area, the cemetery offers loved ones a quiet setting for solitude and reflection among beautifully manicured lawns with a compassionate staff trained to provide grieving family members with support and understanding for peace and comfort in time of sorrow.
